To register your child(ren) for camp, please read and submit all forms together.

Camp attendees must be members in good standing or become members in order to attend Camp Adventure.

Ages 13 and above: \$7

Registration will be considered complete and approved when all forms and fees are submitted and verified accurate by the Boys & Girls Clubs of Southern Rensselaer Administration. **Registration is on a first-come, first served basis. Space is limited.**

Enrollment fees must be paid in full prior to the start date of each camp session. **LATE REGISTRATION: All applications must be submitted by the Wednesday before the week begins.** Applications **will not** be accepted after that date, without exception.

- **10:00 AM: Camp arrival.**
- **4:30 PM: Bus departs camp – All parents picking up at camp grounds must do so by 4:30PM.**
- **5:00 PM: Bus arrives at Rensselaer Clubhouse.**
- **5:30 PM: All campers must be picked up at the Rensselaer Clubhouse.**

Late Pick-Up: The number one priority of the Boys & Girls Clubs of Southern Rensselaer County is the safety of our members. As indicated on the Camp Adventure application, there is a specific pick-up time of 5:30 p.m. At this time, we are unable to provide extended care.

The Camp Adventure pick-up times are extremely important and support our goal of keeping kids safe by having proper staffing ratios.

Late pick-up fees: You will be charged a late fee of \$1.00 per minute for every minute past the pick-up time and no exceptions will be made. Families are welcome to arrive before the designated pick up time. If you know that you are running late, please call to notify the Boys & Girls Clubs staff at (518) 465-3403.

If pick-up times are consistently missed, the Boys & Girls Clubs reserves the right to refuse future attendance. If a child has not been picked up within ten minutes after the specific pick-up time and the Boys & Girls Clubs staff has not been notified by the parent, the Boys & Girls Clubs will attempt to contact the parent(s). If the parent(s) are unreachable, the emergency contacts will then be contacted. If no one can be reached, and the Boys & Girls Clubs has still not been notified of a late-pick up, the Boys & Girls Clubs will contact the Rensselaer Police Department and/or the Department of Social Services as per child care regulations. Multiple infractions of late pick-up will result in forfeiture of camp registration.

Cost:

\$175.00 per child per week. DSS accepted and financial aid is available.

Discounts are available:

- Sibling discount – \$25 a week for second child.
- Pre-payment for 4 weeks or more (one time per family) - \$5 discount for each week paid.

A camper must be registered with all fees paid on the Wednesday prior to the start of each camp week.

Financial Aid: Due to pandemic we were not able to hold any fundraising events last year. We are holding the Cash for Kids fundraiser prior to camp opening. Camperships will be very limited. If you are in need of assistance, please complete the financial aid form and submit proof of income with this application. Camperships are very limited and are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis based on need. Completed financial aid forms with all supporting documentation are due no later than June 11, 2021. Awards will be given by June 21, 2021 based on available funding.

I also understand that in addition to these fees being paid in advance of the start of the session, the health record and registration information is due. Without these items, my child will not be able to attend Camp Adventure. **THIS RULE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED; NO EXCEPTIONS. No refunds will be given after the session begins.**

CAMP ADVENTURE POLICY & BEHAVIOR ACKNOWLEDGEMENT FORM

As camp is beginning, please take the time to review basic cooperative and courteous behavior with your child. If our staff should encounter behavioral difficulties with your child, you will be notified. Depending on the severity and number of occurrences, our staff will make the appropriate determination on a course of action to be taken. This may range from removing a child from a specified activity to suspension from the program. Basic acceptable behavior includes, **but is not limited to:**

1. Use appropriate language at all times
2. Show respect to all campers and staff
3. Respect the property of others
4. Remain with group or buddy at all times, NEVER wander alone
5. No Fighting – verbal nor physical
6. Obey all safety rules
7. Stay in assigned areas

Discipline course of action:

1. Omission from Activities
2. Discipline referral (report)
3. Camp suspension

Note: Any fighting or violent behavior will result in **immediate** camp suspension.

Bus Behavior

1. Stay seated
2. Stay away from windows
3. No food or drinks
4. Keep hands and feet to yourself
5. Use appropriate language and voice volume
6. Do not throw anything

Note: If your child is suspended from the bus for behavior problems, you must provide transportation to and from camp during suspension.

Please understand that no refunds or credits will be given for discipline problems that result in camp suspension.
